### **GENERALIST OBSTETRICIAN AND GYNAECOLOGIST – St. Paul’s Hospital**

#### **Position Summary & Qualifications**

We are seeking applications for a Generalist Obstetrician and Gynaecologist position with clinical faculty appointment in the Division of General Obstetrics and Gynaecology, based at St. Paul’s Hospital. The anticipated start date is May 1, 2025, or a date to be mutually agreed upon.

We are seeking a candidate with a growth mindset and ability to participate in developing multidisciplinary programs in the fields of obstetrics or gynecology. Having advanced training or practical experience in MIGS, pelvic pain/endometriosis, complex OB, complex contraception, pelvic ultrasound (OB or GYN), colposcopy, or menopause is a strong asset.

We are expanding our programs in preparation for the move to the New St. Paul’s Hospital in Spring 2027. The new campus is the largest hospital redevelopment project in BC’s history. This new 11-story building with 546 beds and 16 operating rooms will be a state-of-the-art hospital and one of the most digitally advanced in Canada. The successful applicant will have certification with the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC) and be eligible for licensure to practice from the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC. The incumbent will report to the Site Department Head of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at St. Paul’s Hospital.

St. Paul’s Hospital is one of the major academic centers in Vancouver and this position requires a commitment to clinical education at the undergraduate and post graduate levels. In addition, there is an expectation of personal dedication to the Royal College’s focus on lifelong learning through professional development.

This position is funded by fee for service through the medical services plan of British Columbia, with stipends paid for clinical teaching.
